



# TODD THE FROG

## SKILL LEVEL :



To make this pattern you will need to know how to :

begin with a magic ring ● chain ● slip stitch ● single crochet ● half double crochet ● double crochet ● increase ● invisible decrease ● work FLO ● work BLO ● work in continuous rounds

## GAUGE AND FINISHED SIZE :

Gauge is not essential for this project : you can use any size of hook you want as long as your yarn choice is consistent with it. Just be careful to work tight stitches so as the stuffing doesn't show through.



## SUPPLIES :

- \* Yarn :  
Green  
Yellow, Black, White, Pink & Blue (small amount)
- \* Crochet hook 3.00 mm  
(or any other size consistent with the yarn you chose to make the main parts)
- \* Tapestry needle
- \* Stuffing material (fiberfill)
- \* Pins
- \* Scissors

## ABBREVIATIONS :

- R : round/row  
 MR : magic ring  
 ch : chain  
 st(s) : stitch(es)  
 slst(s) : slip stitch(es)  
 sc : single crochet  
 hdc : half double crochet  
 dc : double crochet  
 inc : increase ( = single crochet 2 stitches in same sc)  
 dec : decrease ( = single crochet 2 stitches in front loops together)  
 FLO : front loops only  
 BLO : back loops only  
 FO : fasten off  
 \*.....\* x... : repeat instructions between \* \* as many times as indicated

## SPECIAL STITCH :

**PUFF STITCH** : *(exemple given for a 3dc puff stitch)*

1. Yarn over (yo), insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over, draw the yarn through the stitch, yarn over, and draw the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook.

*One half-closed double crochet is complete, and 2 loops remain on the hook.*

2. In the same stitch, repeat the preceding step twice.

*You should have 4 loops on your hook.*

3. Yarn over and draw the yarn through all 4 loops on the hook.

*One 3-double-crochet puff stitch is complete.*

## ARMS :

(make 2 using green yarn)

R1 : MR4 (4)  
 R2 : inc around (8)  
 R3 : \*inc, sc\* x4 (12)  
 R4 : 3dc puff stitch, sc 11 (12)  
 R5 : \*dec, sc\* x4 (8)  
 R6 - 13 : sc around (8)

*FO, leave long tail for sewing. (Note : make them first since it might be easier to sew arms on R22 of body before you crochet the head.)*

## LEGS :

(make 2 using green yarn)

R1: MR6 (6)  
 R2 : inc around (12)  
 R3 : inc, sc, inc, [5dc puff stitch, sc] x3, sc, inc, sc (15)  
 R4 : BLO sc around (15)  
 R5 : \*dec, sc3\* x4 (12)  
 R6 - 12 : sc around (12)

- ★ *First leg* : FO and cut yarn. Mark the 4th stitch of the last row. This is where you are going to join second leg.
- ★ *Second leg* : do not fasten off nor cut yarn, keep going with body instructions.

## BODY/HEAD :

(with green yarn)

★ *Connecting legs* :

R13 : Chain 2, join in first leg with 1sc in the marked stitch, crochet around the leg, sc2 in chain, sc around second leg back to stitch marker. (28)  
 R14 : sc around (28)  
 R15 : sc9, inc, sc 11, inc, sc6 (30)  
*Stuff legs*  
 R16 : sc around (30)  
 R17 : \*inc, sc4\* x6 (36)  
 R18 - 19: sc around (36)

R20 : \*dec, sc4\* x6 (30)  
 R21 - 22 : sc around (30)  
 R23 : \*dec, sc3\* x6 (24)  
 R24 : sc around (24)  
 R25 : \*dec, sc2\* x6 (18)  
 R26 : sc around (18)

*Start stuffing body and continue as you go*

R27 : \*dec, sc1\* x6 (12)  
 R28 : sc around (12) ▶ *Now would be a good time for sewing arms ;)*  
 R29 : FLO \*inc, sc\* x6 (18) *Align top of each arm on R22 of the body,*  
 R30 : \*inc, sc2\* x6 (24) *pin and sew on place.*  
 R31 : sc around (24)  
 R32 : \*inc, sc3\* x6 (30)  
 R33 : \*inc, sc4\* x6 (36)  
 R34 : \*inc, sc3\* x9 (45)  
 R35- 43 : sc around (45)  
 R44 : \*dec, sc3\* x9 (36)  
 R45 : \*dec, sc4\* x6 (30)  
 R46 : \*dec, sc3\* x6 (24)

*With pink yarn embroider cheeks on R36 leaving 12 stitches in between. With black yarn, embroider mouth, then embroider nostrils on R40 leaving a space of 4 stitches inbetween.*

R47 : \*dec, sc2\* x6 (18)  
 R48 : \*dec, sc\* x6 (12)  
 R49 : close hole with tapestry needle

## EYES : (Part 1)

*(make 2 using green yarn)*

R1 : ch4, in 2nd ch from hook : inc, sc, inc, sc.

*Insert stitch marker here*

R2 : inc around (12)  
 R3 : \*inc, sc\* x6 (18)  
 R4 - 7 : sc around (18)

*FO, leave long tail for sewing.*

**EYES :** (Part 2)

(make 2 with black, blue & white yarn)

*Start with black yarn*

R1 : MR6 (6)

*Change to blue yarn*

R2 : \*2slst in next stitch, slst 1\*x3 (9)

R3 : \*inc, sc2\* x3 (12)

*Change to white yarn*

R4 : slst around (18)

*FO, leave long tail for sewing.*

*Embroider detail on eyes with white yarn and sew on Part 1.*

*Pin Part 1 on each side of the head between R38 & 45, start sewing and stuff before sewing is complete.*

**CROWN :**

(with yellow yarn)

R1 : ch 15, join in 1st stitch with a slst

R2 - 4 : sc around (15)

R5 : \*ch3, slst in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next, sc2\* x7, ch3, slst in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next, sc 1.

*FO, leave long tail for sewing.*



Now you can kiss your little frog on the nose  
and do a little happy dance !
